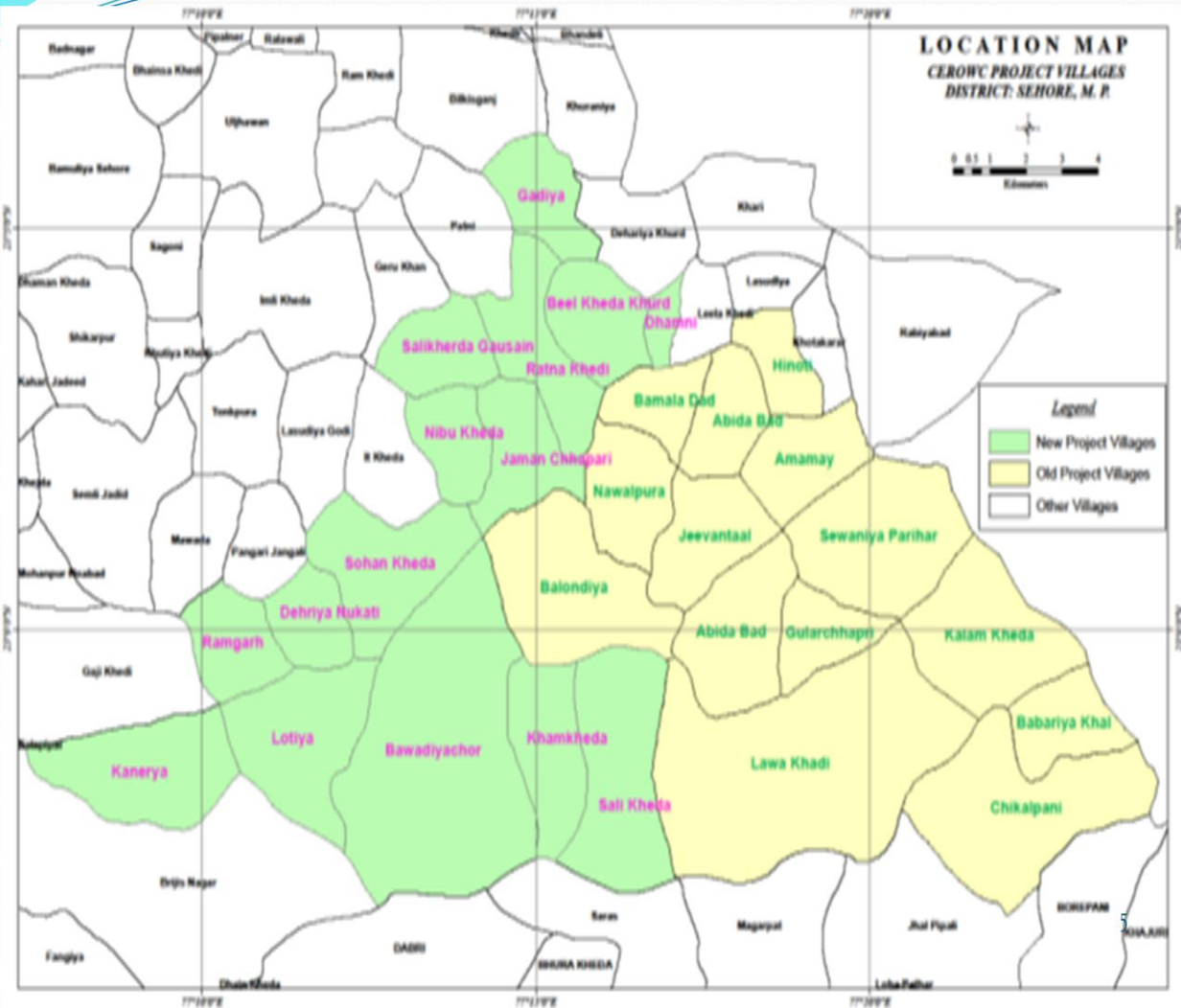

Outcome assessment

- 50 SHGs functioning in the 15 project villages with 554 members .
- 15 farmer clubs functioning in the 15 project villages with 499 members
- The cumulative saving of the 50 SHGs amounts of Rs. 9,99,559 out of which Rs.5,01,550 is circulated among the members in the form of internal lending, Rs.3,24,376 in saving bank accounts and Rs.1,73,633 in the form of cash in hand/box.
- 26 SHGs linked with ICICI/MPGB / BOM banks and received Rs. 26,89,000 - as loan for IGA and agricultural activities.
- 42 SHG associated /linked with NRLM (National Rural Livelihood Mission) and 42 SHG received a corpus Rs. 10,000 each SHG.
- 13 Village Level Federations(VLFs) are functioning in the target villages and associated to NRLM and generated a fund of 31,462/- by SHG contribution for administration purpose.
- 7 VLF got loan from Cluster Level Federation (CLF)Rs 14,75,000 under the community investment fund of NRLM.

- 06 Water User Committees (WUCs) are established and they monitor the construction of WHS in the villages. The maintenance fund collected by these WUCs as on December 2023 is Rs. 21000/ -
- 100 Master trainers are identified and trained. They have completed 2 modules of sustainable agriculture training
- 5294 trees planted in 13 project village with 211 farmers .A survey conducted in December 2023 shows that survival rate is 78.88%.
- 281 families grow vegetable in kitchen garden units and produced total 32.50 tons kilograms of vegetable and used for domestic consumption .
- 322 compost pits established in 14 target villages and produced 1031.87 MT organic manure.
- 528 farmers are assisted for land improvement. Land improvement measures have been made in 422.4 acres of land.

- Carried out bunding activity in 38.038 km to treat an area of 233.25 hectares of land belonging to 326 farmers
- Almost 596 farmers implementing sustainable agriculture methods on 703 hectors land and have increased their yield by 21 %.
- The project trained 86 (59 male +27 female) youths in different trades, like masonry , ITI B.Sc. Nursing Electrician technician, Automobile repair , Bed side nursing, Tailoring , Electric motor rewinding, Beautician etc. The monthly salary workout Rs. 7500 approximately.
- 15 seed bank units established with a stock of 15000 kg of seed benefitting 143 families.
- 15 grain bank units established with a stock of 15000 kilograms of grain benefitting 136 families.
- 80 families cultivating large scale vegetable in area of 16.38 hector of land and produced 62,123 kilograms of vegetable

- 100 farmers are cultivating climate resistant crops like ginger , turmeric, cassava etc in area of 19.34 hectors of land and produced 16,210 kg of ginger and 165 kg. turmeric.
- 20 motor/diesel pump sets ,1266 pipes and 440 sprinklers are distributed to 20 SHGs/Groups in 12 villages and 157 Farmers irrigated their 171.4 hector of land by this equipment's.
- 06 farm ponds are constructed and 72 farmers irrigated their 79.8 acres of land and 15 acre land become cultivable . Till now WUC collected Rs.21000 as maintenance fund.
- 125 Families started income generation activities such as grocery, cloth store ,mobile repair shop, photocopy shop, motor cycle repair shop, flour mill, cow rearing with the help of the project
